It's Almost That Time Again...... Winterizing Your Boat

Enclosed you will find a winter work order form (if you have an outboard); please fill the form out completely and return it to the office. You can mail or fax the form back to us (fax # (302) 422-5475) If you have any question feel free to call the service department. The boats are winterized in the order the service department receives the forms and The Marina is not responsible for any damage because of freezing.

Some other winter recommendations:

- *Remove all soda cans/bottles, just imagine the mess when they freeze and break.
- *Now is a good time to have that damaged prop reconditioned. We have prop service at the Marina.
- *Remove all electronics.
- *A strong recommendation would be to cover your boat with a poly tarp to cut down on dust or in case the boat above you has a problem over the winter.
- *If you are trailering your boat, remember to grease your wheel bearings, check lights, winch cables, tire pressure and lug
- * Make sure your trailer registration is current.
- * Leave keys and batteries in the boat until the marina is finished winterizing the boat.
- Leave as little gas in the boat for the winter as possible



2020 has been a fantastic year for boat sales and continues to be so. We are working to refresh our inventory over the winter season.
